#### Course Objective:

Verification of Competency (VOC) is a method of assessment that assists employers to meet WHS requirements and ensure staff and or contractors are competent to operate equipment, perform a task, or for site equipment. VOC's are undertaken for pre-employment purposes, for existing works undertaking new roles or tasks within a company and for pre-commencement of contractors.

#### Course Outcome:

On successful completion students will be issued with Verification of Competency (VOC), which is valid for five years. If a satisfactory standard has not been achieved gap training would be required to complete the VOC.

#### Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical: note one machine per operator.

This unit is competency based e.g. log book and or declaration of experience is required. Courses are run on demand.

#### Pre-requisites

All students must have a unique student identifier (USI) to obtain their nationally accredited certificate or qualification. To apply for a USI go to [www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au)

- Students must be 18 years of age, be able to speak and understand basic English to communicate to a level to perform their duties
- Photo Identification : driver's license, passport or proof of age card
