Course Objective:

Provide participants with the skills and knowledge to conduct backhoe loader operations in the civil construction industry.

Course Outcome:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a notice of assessment and a wallet sized duty of care card

Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical

Courses are normally 4 .5 hrs. duration and are run on demand

Machine assessments occur only when the participant can demonstrate competency, or with a logbook, signed declaration stating their machine experience or a 3rd party declaration from their employer with machinery operated and position/experience held.

Course Content

- Conduct routine pre start checks
- Plan and prepare for backhoe loader operation
- Operate backhoe loader
- Load carry and place materials
- Select, fit use and remove attachments
- Shut down equipment and relocate
- Secure site

Pre-requisites / Clothing & Equipment Requirements

- Students must be 18 years of age and able to speak, read and understand basic English to communicate to a safe level.
- Students must provide photo identification upon enrolment in the course (e.g. driver's licence; passport or proof of age card)
- Students must wear personal protective equipment while attending the course including long sleeve shirt, steel capped boots and long trousers.
