Course Objective:

Quick Cut Saw is used for the cutting of concrete and masonry products in the civil construction industry. This course provides participants with the skills and knowledge to enable them to plan, safely operate and carry out basic maintenance on a quick cut saw in the civil construction industry.

Course Outcome: On successful completion of this course participants will be issued with duty of care wallet size card.

Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical: note small group course. Courses are normally 4 hours in duration and are run on demand at our site at 336 Diment Road Burton SA 5110

Course Content

- Plan and prepare for quick cut operation, identify hazards
- Conduct pre operational checks
- Use quick cut saw and demonstrate safe cutting techniques, wet and dry cutting, cutting slabs and understanding kickback
- Carry out operator maintenance
- Clean up

Pre-requisites / Clothing & Equipment Requirements

- Students must be able to speak, read and understand basic English to communicate to a safe level
- Students must provide photo identification upon enrolment in the course (e.g. driver's licence; passport or proof of age card)
- Students must wear personal protective equipment while attending the course including long sleeve shirt, steel capped boots and long trousers. (Red Earth Training Solutions will supply high vis vest if required,, hard hat, visor / safety glasses, ear muffs and heavy duty gloves.
